Sir:-


I have the honor to inform you that in giving up my office as President of the local Board of Health I shall lose the services of the clerical help which has heretofore enabled me to perform the various duties assigned me as Inspector and Special disbursing Officer of the Presidio, making the payments at the Carcel, and attending to the various other official matters that from time to time have been referred to me.

I therefore request authority to hire a clerk at not to exceed \$75.00 per month until such time as these various duties are completed. There is unfinished work that will require the services of such a clerk for at least three months. If it is possible to dispense with such services ~~ea~~ earlier I will report the fact.

The pay of such clerk might well be taken from the unexpended balance of Insular funds turned over to me by the proceeding Department Commander for this general work and which I am (through the Inspector General) directed to turn into the Insular Treasury. The amount to be thus turned in will be about \$1500.00.
