Sir.

With a view to having the councils equally, represented from the late parties of liberals and radicals, who have now agreed to work as one on the islands, you will please have the County Officers of posts ascertain and submit to me the names of the men composing the councils in your district, giving the party which each one is supposed to represent; also, in order to carry out the above, the names of reliable men, with party, whom they recommend for appointment, and the name of those they recommend for relief.

The indifference of some of the councils to education of children on American methods and by American teachers is not approved and will result in such men being relieved from councils and more progressive men put in their places.

Please give this important matter your prompt and earnest attention.
