

The Grand Jury for the November term of the United States District Court, Porto Rico, was empanelled on the 7th day of November, 1921, and after being sworn, the Judge of the Court, the Hon. Arthur F. Odlin, appointed Mr. Henry W. Dooley as foreman of the Grand Jury and the oath was administered to him.

The Court charged the Jury in regard to their duties and obligations.

The Grand Jury then adjourned to the jury room where the United States District Attorney, Hon. Ira K. Wells, and the Assistant United States District Attorney, Hon. Andres B. Crossas, appeared before the Grand Jury and outlined various matters and cases which they wished to present.

The Grand Jury met during November, on the 7th and 8th, and during the month of December, on the 5th, 28th, 29th and 30th, adjourning on the 30th to meet on January 24th, 1922.

On January 10th, 1922, however, the members of the Grand Jury were cited by the Court to reassemble on the morning of January 12th, 1922, at 9:00 a.m., and for the Jury to be in the courtroom at that hour. The Court stated
